

2019 Peeps® Diorama Contest Rules



Diorama display can have any theme, as long as it is “family friendly” (Suitable for all audiences).

Examples include: books, movies, television shows, musicals, historical scenes, science



- ◆ Diorama parts should all fit inside a box the size of a shoe box. You may remove one or more sides of the box if you wish.
- ◆ All visible parts of the diorama can be decorated, including the outside of the box.
- ◆ All characters in your scene should be made using Peeps®
- ◆ Limit one entry per person or team. For teams, choose the category of your oldest team member.
- ◆ **Dioramas with attached entry forms are to be submitted by Saturday, March 30.** Drop them off at the Information Desk.
- ◆ The winners will be announced at our **Peeps® Party: Monday April 15 at 7pm**. All participants and the public are invited to attend.
- ◆ Voting for the PEEPLES CHOICE AWARD will take place between April 1 to April 14th.
- ◆ The dioramas in each of the categories will be on display in the Children’s Department from March 30-April 15, and **must be picked up Tuesday, April 16 by 9pm**; otherwise they will be discarded.
- ◆ The library is not responsible for damage and will do it’s best to keep your diorama safe. By entering the diorama contest, you are giving Reed Memorial Library permission to display your diorama in the library, take pictures of your creation and share them online.
